Peter Clentzos, Past Supreme Athletic Director, Scholar - Athlete Award

Established in 2012 by the Athletic Booster Club in memory of PSAD, who also was Chairman of the Hall of Fame Selection Committee from 1975 - 2007. Awarded annually to an outstanding High School Graduating Senior Hellene in the field of athletics, with at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA in a 4.0 scale. Individual is to be considered a top player in his/her State and must be enrolled in a college by November 2012. The award is for \$1,000

Dr. Kimon Doukas Collegiate Scholar-Athlete Award

Awarded annually to the outstanding Collegiate Scholar Athlete and given to a duly matriculated incoming junior or senior student, outstanding academically and in athletics. The award is for \$1,000.

Frank Manios, PSP of AHEPA - Scholar/ Athlete and Service Award

The recipient is selected because he or she has exemplified outstanding **combined** achievements in **academics, athletics, community service, and/or extra curricular activities**. The award is for \$1,000.

Dr. Monthe N. Kofos, Past Supreme Athletic Director, Scholar – Athlete Award

Established in 2009 by the Athletic Booster Club in memory of AHEPA's Supreme Athletic Director, who was elected to 40 continuous year terms from 1969-2008. Awarded annually to an outstanding High School Senior thru College Junior with at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA in a scale of 4.0. Individual should be considered a top player in his/her State or Conference. The award is for \$2,000.

John Peter Vlahos Scholar-Athlete Award

Awarded annually to the Outstanding High School Scholar- Athlete of Hellenic Descent. Established by John Peter Vlahos in memory of his son Dean J. Vlahos. Qualifications: The recipient must be a high school senior with at least a 3.2 grade point average in a scale of 4.0 and outstanding in athletics. The award is for \$3,000.

Louis G. Manesiotis, PSP of AHEPA - Scholar-Athlete Award

Established in 2012 in memory of PSP and lifetime supporter of AHEPA Athletics, Lou Manesiotis. Awarded annually to an outstanding High School Graduating Senior Hellene in the field of athletics, with at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA in a 4.0 scale. Individual is to be considered a top player in his/her State.

The recipient must be registered as a college student by November 2012. The award is for \$1,000.

Excellence in Athletics Award Offered by Supreme Order of AHEPA- Athletic Department

To be awarded on an annual basis for excellence and outstanding achievement in High School Athletics to the outstanding Greek American High School Athlete in the United States. Established in 1990 by the AHEPA Athletic Boosters Club, and created through the donations of hundreds of supporters. This award is representative of the Order's highest offering regarding High School Athletic Competition. Qualifications: AHEPA Chapters and Chapter Athletic Directors are to submit a single name representative of their area whom they believe to be outstanding in High School athletic competition in the Greek American Community & Nationwide as well whom they believe to be the best athletic achiever. This person must be a H.S. senior who has been accepted to an accredited college by 11-1-2012. The award is for \$2,000. Additional awards may be granted depending on the number of qualified applications..
